# RESOLUTION TO AMEND 2020 BUDGET SORREL RANCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Sorrel Ranch Metropolitan District shall and hereby does further amend the Budget for the fiscal year 2020 and adopts a supplemental budget and appropriation for the General Fund and Debt Service Fund for the fiscal year 2020, as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such sums are hereby appropriated from the revenues of the District to the proper funds for the purposes stated.
